



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## **Install the Fixture**



- Install the side glass panels by carefully inserting them in the frame and securing them using the small clips.
- Install the top glass panels by carefully inserting them in the cover and securing them using the large clips and clip screws.
- Install the cover to the top of the frame using the cover screws.
- Slide the door glass panel into the door frame and secure it in place using the tabs.
- Install the candle tubes by sliding them over the sockets.
- 6 Screw the lamps into the sockets. Refer to the label on the lamp socket for Max Wattage Information.
- 7 Connect the fixture to a suitable ground in accordance with local electrical codes.
- 8 Connect the white fixture wire to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- **9** Connect the black fixture wire to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- Secure the fixture to the post with the post screws making sure to neatly tuck in all wiring.
