

- **I** Secure the mounting plate to the junction box.
- 2 Connect the fixture ground wire to a suitable ground in accordance to local electrical codes.
- 3 Connect the white fixture wire to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- 4 Connect the black fixture wire to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- **5** Properly place all wires and wire nut connections into the junction box/fixture base, mount the fixture onto the mounting plate, and secure it in place with the set screw using the Allen wrench.
- 6 Place the shade over the socket, then secure it in place by screwing the collar nut onto the socket. Repeat for remaining shades.
- **7** Screw the lamp(s) into the socket(s). Refer to the label on the socket for Max Wattage Information.
- Install the finial to the bottom of the fixture and secure it in place using the bolt. Repeat for remaining finials.
